To Whom It May Concern:

I am an attorney with iN Demand L.L.C. ("iN DEMAND"), the producer of Howard Stern's uncensored television programs. iN Demand is the exclusive licensee of Howard Stern television shows. It has come to our attention that you are distributing pirated Howard Stern television programs (the "Stern Shows") through the website <http://www.sterntv.net/>. Neither The Howard Stern Production Company ("Stern") nor iN Demand has ever authorized you to distribute content from the Stern Shows, and you have no authorization or permission to distribute the Stern Shows. Your distribution of the Stern's and iN Demand's intellectual property rights constitutes copyright infringement under federal law. Distributing these Stern Shows without express written consent from either iN DEMAND or Stern could subject you to both criminal and civil liability.


Accordingly, please consider this letter a formal demand that you immediately cease and desist all sales and/or other distribution of all Stern Shows.

Please promptly contact me to confirm your intent to immediately cease and desist the sale or other distribution of the Stern Shows. We will then forward to you an agreement affirming your understanding.

Nothing contained in the foregoing shall prejudice iN DEMAND's rights and remedies at law or in equity with regard to this matter, all of which are hereby expressly reserved.

Time is of the essence with regard to this issue, and we therefore request that you respond to the matters raised herein on or before June 27, 2008.
